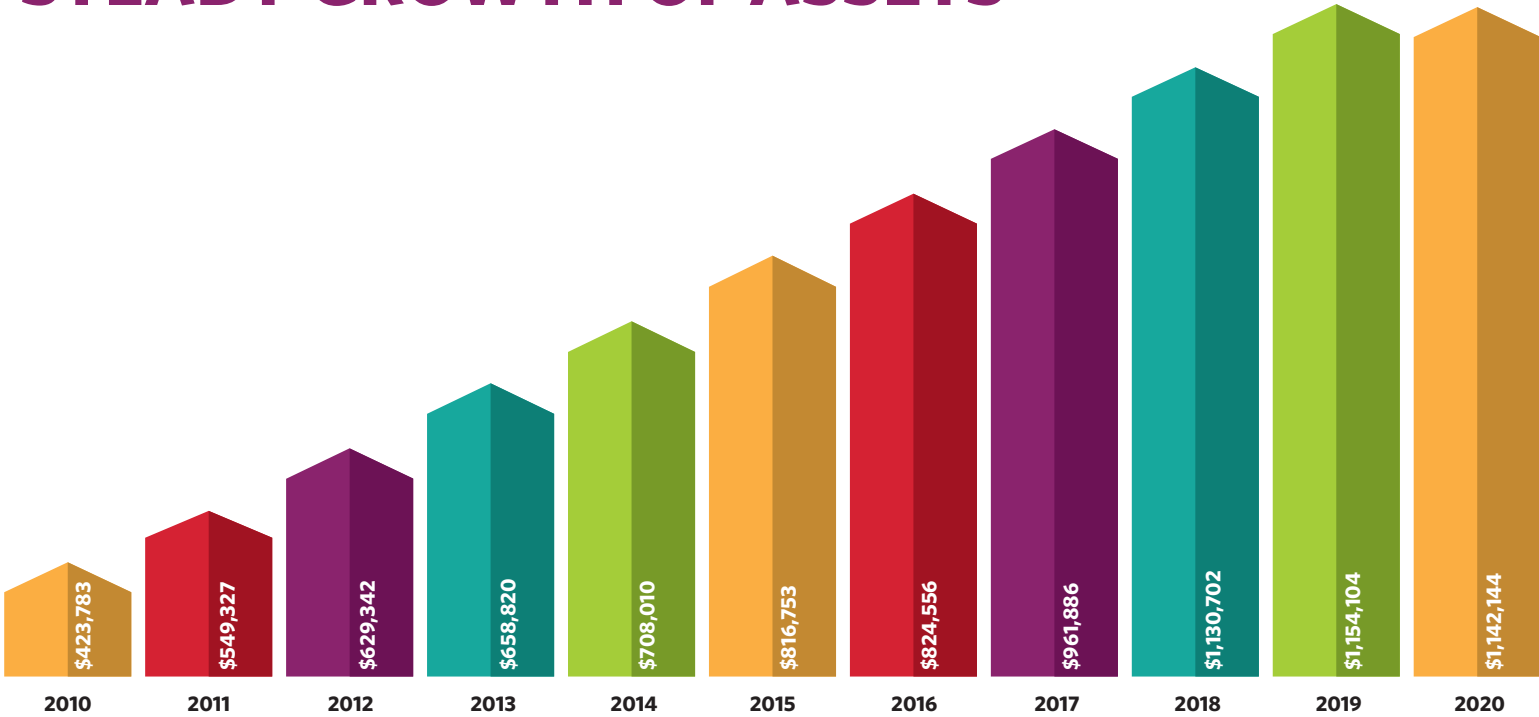
**FOUNDATION DONORS**

Despite the market volatility and investment losses due to COVID-19, fiscal year 2020 still ended strong, with total contributions of \$441,070 and a positive net income of \$24,606. **This is the 11th consecutive year of positive fund growth.** Nearly \$250,000 was granted via scholarships, program grants, and project awards. The Foundation maintains three years of projected operating funds in CDs, cash, or money market investments. The Form 990 is available upon request at the CRCSF office.
