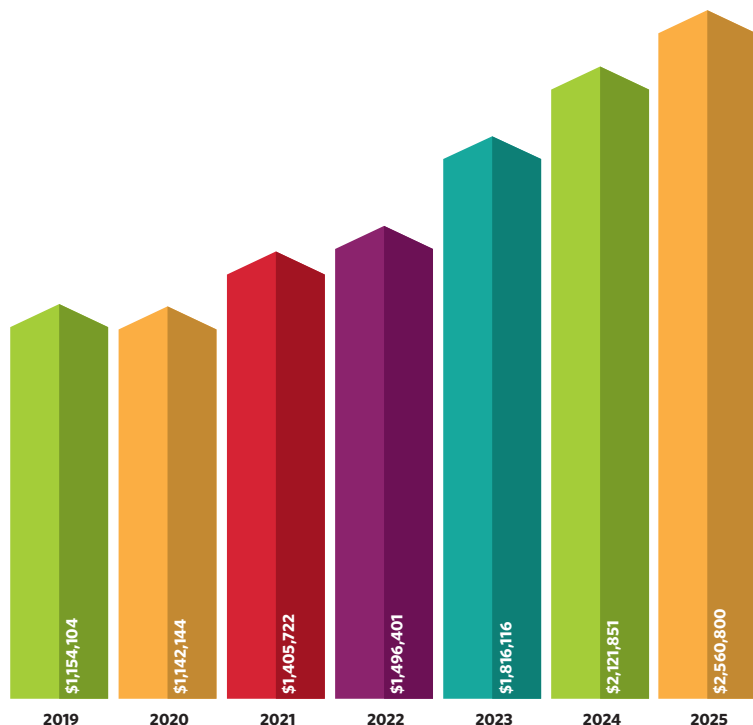
**FOUNDATION DONORS**

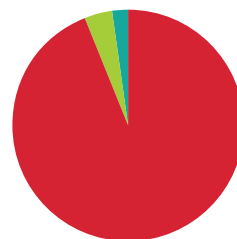
## STEADY GROWTH OF ASSETS

In FY2025, contributions to CRCSF were spent on:

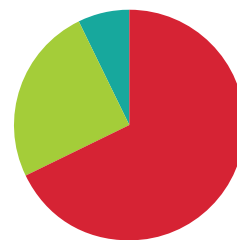
**94% Programming**
