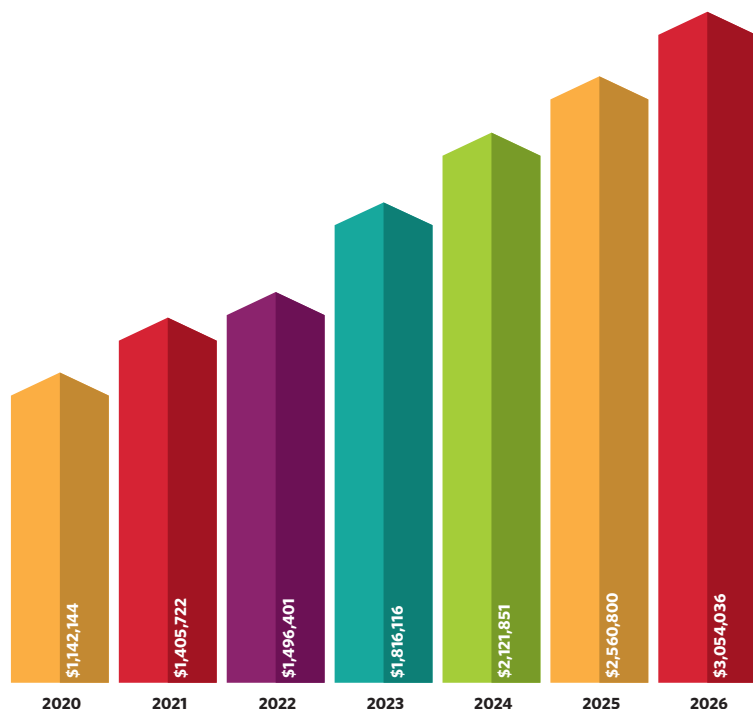

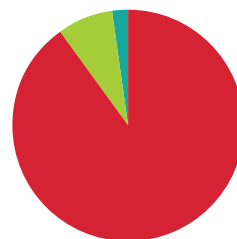
STEADY GROWTH OF ASSETS

In FY2026, contributions to CRCSF were spent on:

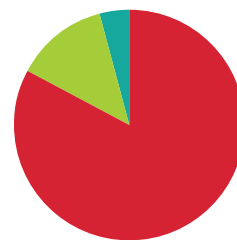
90% Programming
